## Disclosure Statement

I hereby declare that

- I have **no** financial interest **nor** any conflict of interest stemming from my participation as coauthor in the paper: "Estimating Neighborhood Choice Models: Lessons from a Housing Assistance Experiment".
- The original submission used data obtained under a restricted-use agreement with the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Under that agreement, HUD had the right to review the paper before publication to ensure that the privacy of experimental participants was not inadvertently compromised. However, the current resubmission is based on the same data now obtained through a new restricted-use agreement with the Inter-University Consortium for Political and Social Research (ICPSR). This is where the very same data is now permanently archived. Under the new agreement with ICPSR many similar protocols are in place to prevent identification of respondents, however, no party has the right to review the paper before publication.
