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We very much appreciate these comments. We certainly agree that low power is a limitation of our study (which we raise on page 76). We also note that low power means that the relationships we are able to detect are likely to be true ones (and others which are statistically insignificant but suggested by our point estimates may be true relationships too). There are other nuances in interpretation as well. For example, given that our estimates identify treatment effects for the subset of compliers in the sample, full sample means may not be the only appropriate benchmark for assessing implied effect sizes. Comparisons with standard deviations as well as means are also reasonable. These are important issues for readers to bear in mind, and we are grateful to Bob for raising them.
