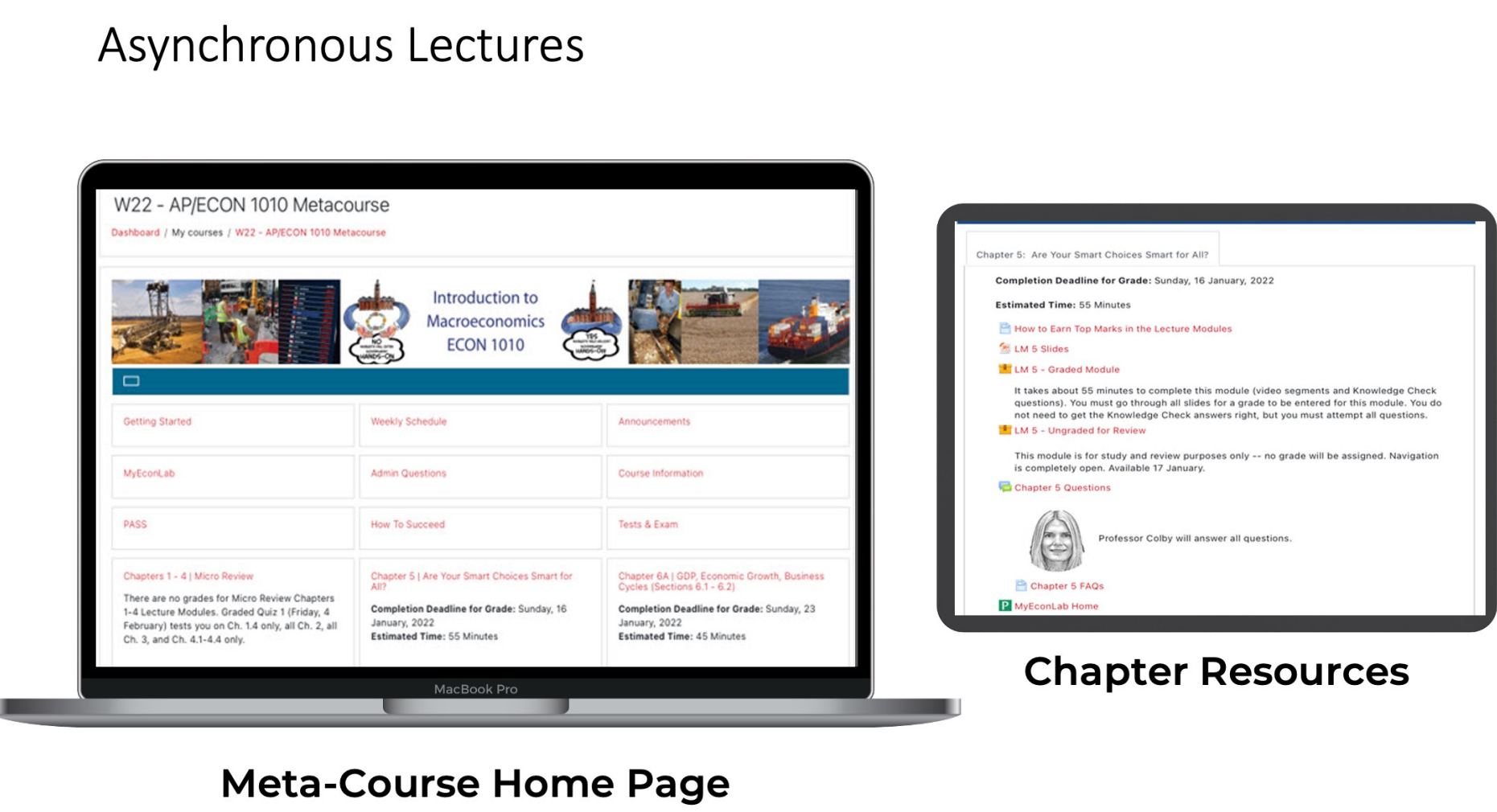


## Transformation – Key Components

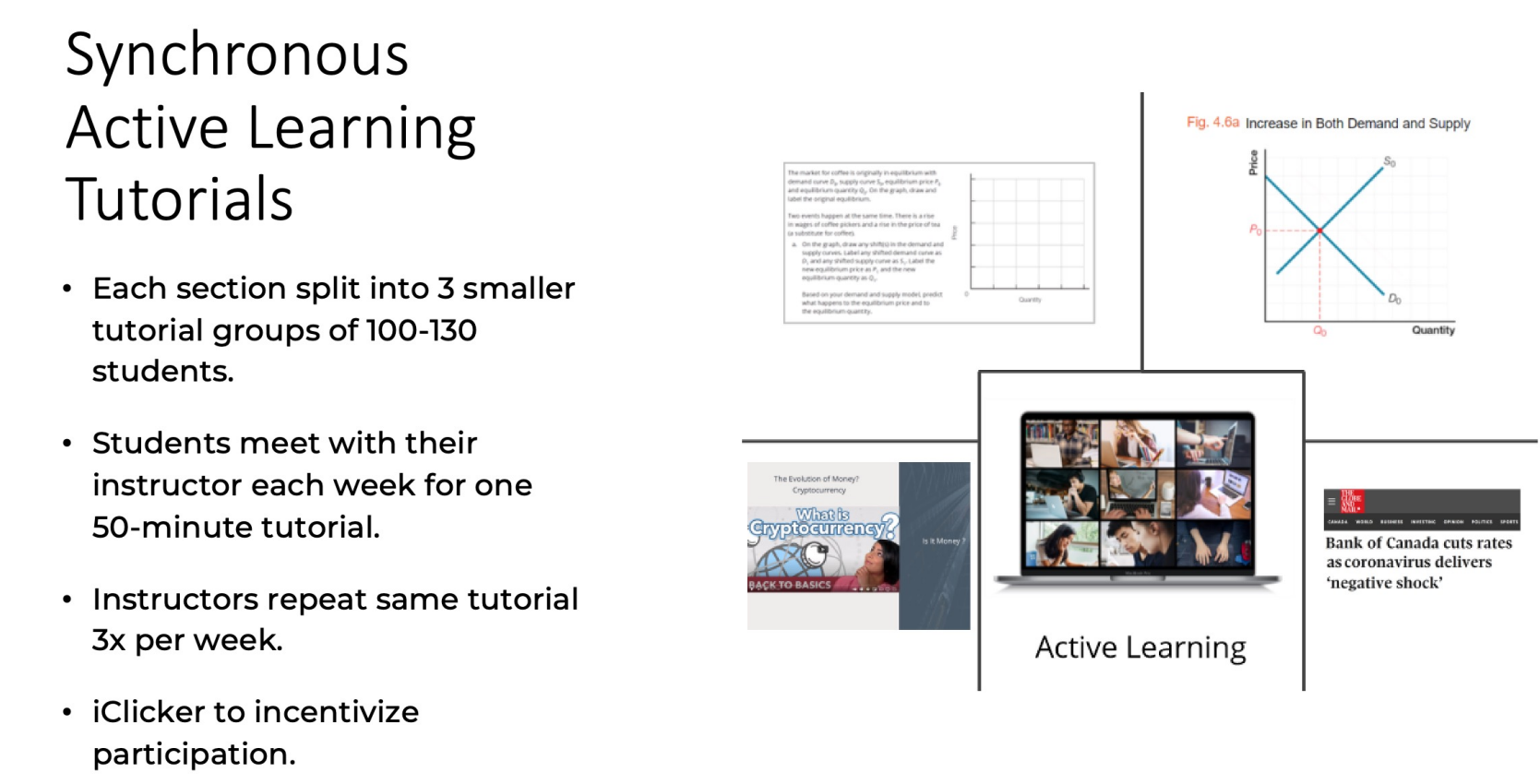
### Team-Teaching Model

We radically transformed our principles courses from a conventional multi-section, large-lecture, passive learning format, to a single meta-course for 3000 students that exploits economies of scale for a richer, more flexible, engaging, student experience.

There are only two possible scores for each Lecture Module, either 1 (100%) or 0.

To earn a score of 1, you must watch all videos and answer all Knowledge Check questions. Those questions are designed to help you learn, as well as do better on tests and exams. You do not need to get the Knowledge Check answers right, but you must attempt all questions.

You must finish all material by the completion due date on the Weekly Schedule and eClass website.

Your iClicker grade for each Tutorial session is based on participation only. Full Marks as long as you answer all but 1 of the iClicker questions, regardless of whether your answers are correct or not. Missing more than 1 iClicker question in a given session results in a score of 0 for that week.

## Post-transformation - Results

Measurable Redesign Results

- Online Lecture Module completion rates **average 90%** (vs. <40% attendance in-person pre-pandemic).
- Tutorial participation rates **average 84%** (vs. no tutorials pre-pandemic).
- Tests and exam **grade distributions are normal**.
- ECON 1000 **retention increase 9%**  
ECON 1010 **retention increase 7%**  
Translates to **580 additional course enrolments!**
- On student evaluations, the redesigned courses have **higher satisfaction scores in every category**.
- Positive student and instructor feedback.

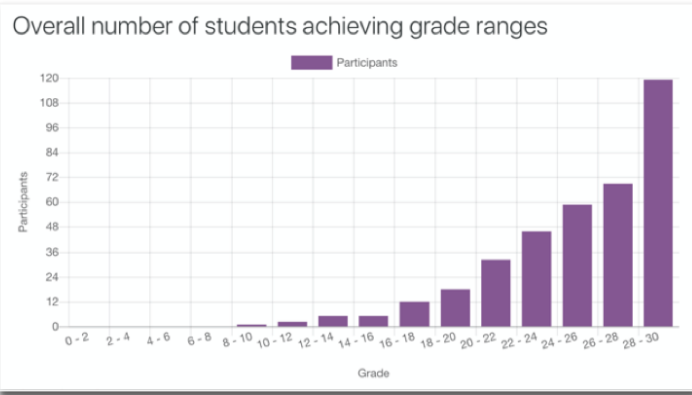

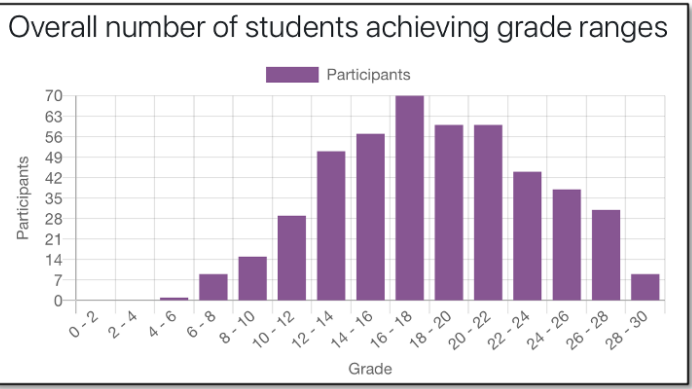

- Tests consisted largely of publisher test bank questions.
- Create new multiple-choice test questions.
- Synchronous, timed tests; question pooling; randomized order of questions and answers within questions; sequential navigation; academic honesty/rough work sheet submission requirement.
- Test distributions normal with averages in the mid 60s.
