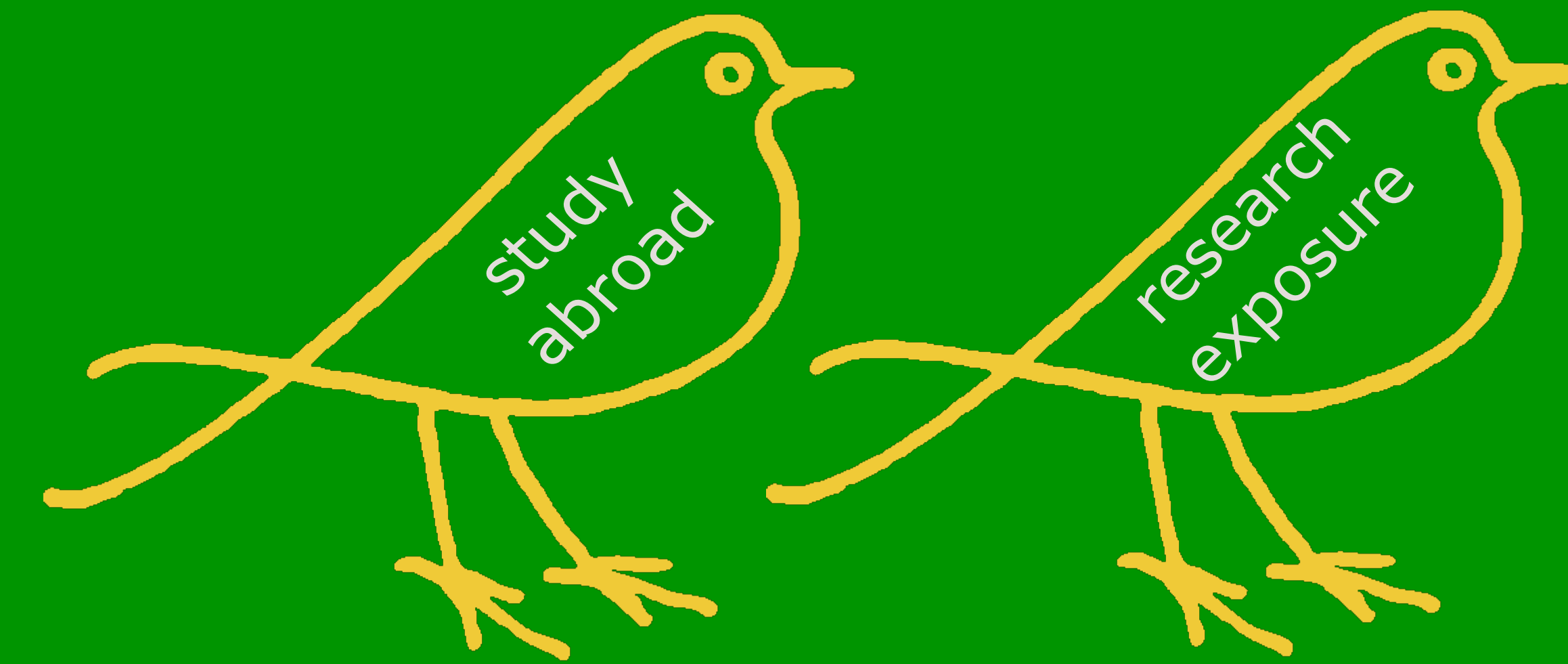

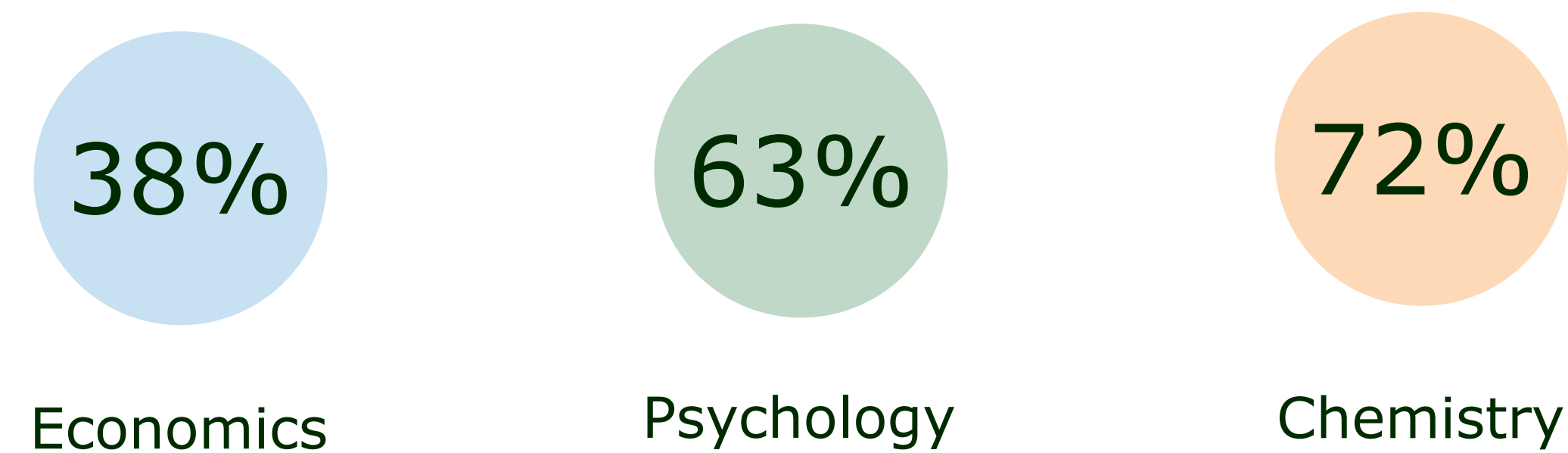
Students on different continents engage with economics research in joint online classroom.
