The data used in this research were made available by the Charities Aid Foundation (CAF) and comprise transactions records from CAF donor accounts. The data were accessed on a secure CAF server with all information regarding name, address, ID details, telephone number and town/city removed by CAF prior to being made available thus ensuring complete anonymity. The account-level transactions data are held by CAF and cannot be disclosed for confidentiality reasons as doing so may make it possible to identify individuals.
