(2) Involvement with Interested Parties: Goolsbee served as a member of the *Council of Economic Advisers*, Chief Economist for the *President's Economic Recovery Advisory Board* and a designated member of the President's Automobile Task Force from 2009 to 2010. As the paper makes clear, he was directly involved in the deliberations and decisions about rescuing and restructuring the U.S. auto industry. He served as Chairman of the *Council of Economic Advisers* from 2010 to 2011 which continued to have an interest in the success of the auto industry. Since 2011, Goolsbee has given paid speeches to many economic, financial, industrial, nonprofit and university groups. Some of those speeches have been to entities likely to be commercially involved with the automobile industry as suppliers, investors, lenders, consultants or commercial partners but he does not have direct knowledge of conflicts of interest or of the extent of their business involvement as he served only as a keynote speaker at meetings and conferences.
